


Bylaw Process Milestones

Intention & Drafting

Section 7 (2)
The Commission may
make by-laws, the

be shown in plan form.



Notice of Inspection & Hearing

Section 9 (1)


The Commission, before making, amending or repealing a by-law, shall give notice of its intention so to do by advertisement inserted at least once a week for two successive weeks in a newspaper circulating in the Area, the first of such notices to be published at least three clear weeks before the date fixed for the hearing of objections.

Section 9(2)

- (a) requires a place where, and the hours during which, the by-law may be inspected by any interested person. The department confirms that this may be accomplished online.
- (b) indicates notice to include the time and place set for hearing by the Commission of objections to the by-law. The format of the hearing is not prescribed.

Section 9 (3)

The Commission shall make suitable provision for inspection of the proposed by-law by interested persons and shall, before making, amending, or repealing the by-law, consider all objections thereto made at such hearing.



Minister Approval & Filing

Section 8

Two copies of every by-law made by the Commission under the provisions of this Act, or the amendment of repeal of a by-law, shall be transmitted to the Minister of Economic Development.

Section 10

The application to the Minister for his approval ... shall be accompanied by proof of compliance ... of Section 9; and a report of all objections to the by-law submitted to the Commission by interested persons.

Section 11

A by-law made by the Commission and approved by the Minister shall be filed in the office of the Registrar of Deeds for the Registration District of the County of Halifax."

Section 13

By-law deemed made when filed For the purposes of this Section, a by-law is deemed to be made by the Commission when it is filed in the office of the Registrar of Deeds pursuant to Section 11.
